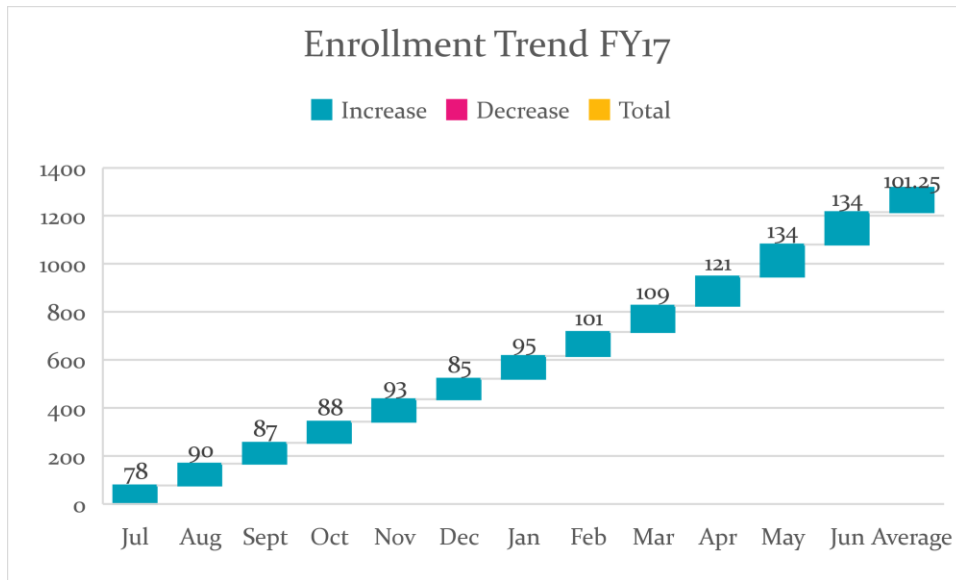

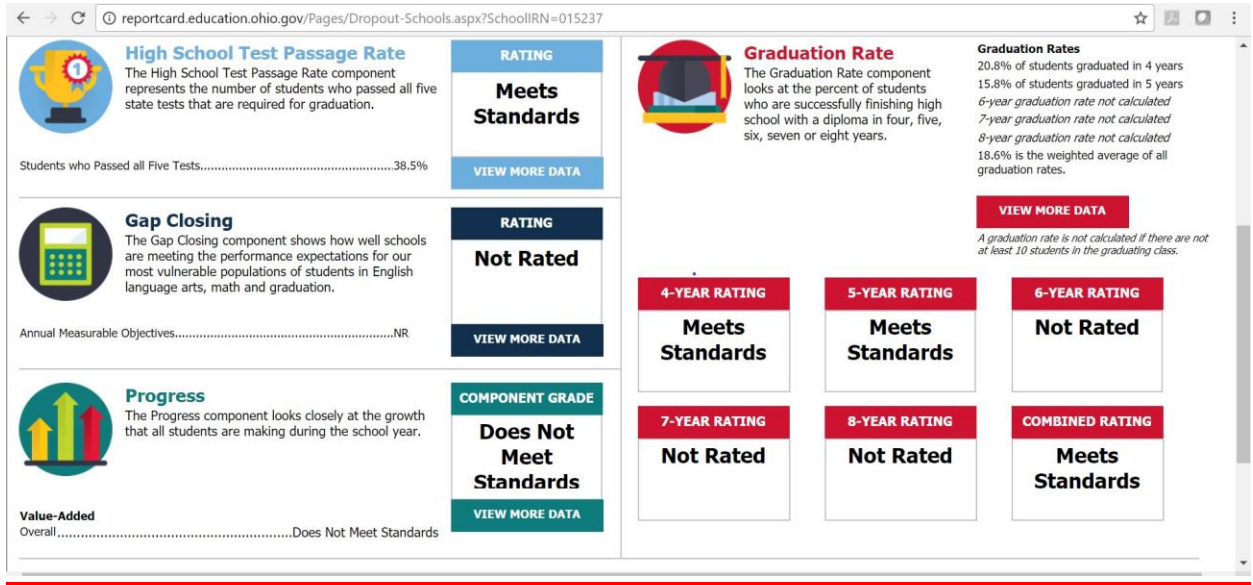

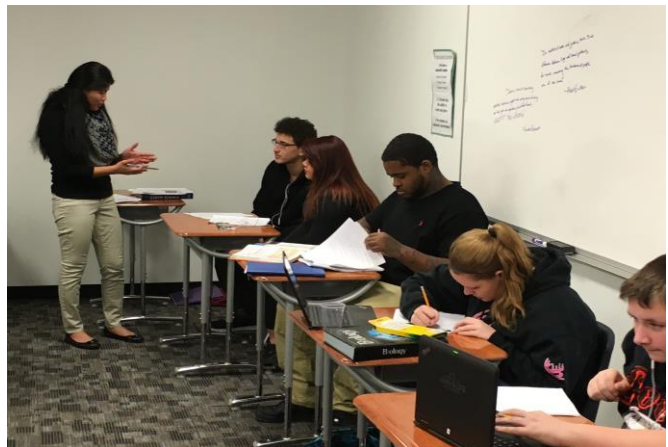

# Testing

**AIR Testing: Students at FLEX High school performed higher than the state average in all subjects across Fall and Spring testing.**

<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• 100 % Proficient and 36 Points higher than state average in ELA 2</li><li>• 8 Points higher than the state average in Physical Science</li><li>• 40% Above Proficient</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• We out tested the State in Algebra 1 by 11 points</li><li>• We out tested the State in Geometry by 14 points</li><li>• We out tested the State in ELA 1 by 8 points</li><li>• We out tested the State in Biology by 49 points</li><li>• We out tested the State in Government by 12 points</li><li>• We out tested the State in American History by 37 points</li></ul>
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**OGT: 38.5% of Students at FLEX High school scored proficient on The Ohio Graduation Test. Fall to Spring statistics are as follows:**

- **100% of the students that tested in the fall at FLEX High School improved on the Spring test in at least 1 Area**
- **73% of the Students Improved in Math with 22 Points being the Average Growth**
- **63% of the Students Improved in Writing with 19 Points being the Average Growth**
- **81% of the Students Improved in Reading with 24 Points being the Average Growth**
- **20 points was the Average Gain on the OGT**
